



CRITERIA

Two fully-funded places to the Arctic Experience

There are 4 criteria that must be met to be eligible to win a fully-funded Arctic Race4Good® experience. These include:

1

The candidates will be from one of the **top three winning teams** from the online Arctic Race4Good starting in October 2022.*

2

The candidates will have made a **significant contribution** to the Arctic Race4Good.**

3

The shortlisted **nine** students from the **top three** teams must then write, in person, to Linda Cruse and explain why (in less than 250 words) why they should be selected.

4

Five of these nine students will be invited to attend a 30-minute zoom interview with Linda, and one of the business sponsors.

After which, **two** candidates will be selected.

*The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed teams are chosen by an independent panel of judges in the Arctic Race4Good final.

** Three students from each team will be selected by the staff lead on the basis of: engagement, punctuality and attendance, commitment to the project, willingness to take on and research individual tasks, greatest empathy displayed, the most significant 'perceived' benefit to that individual.
